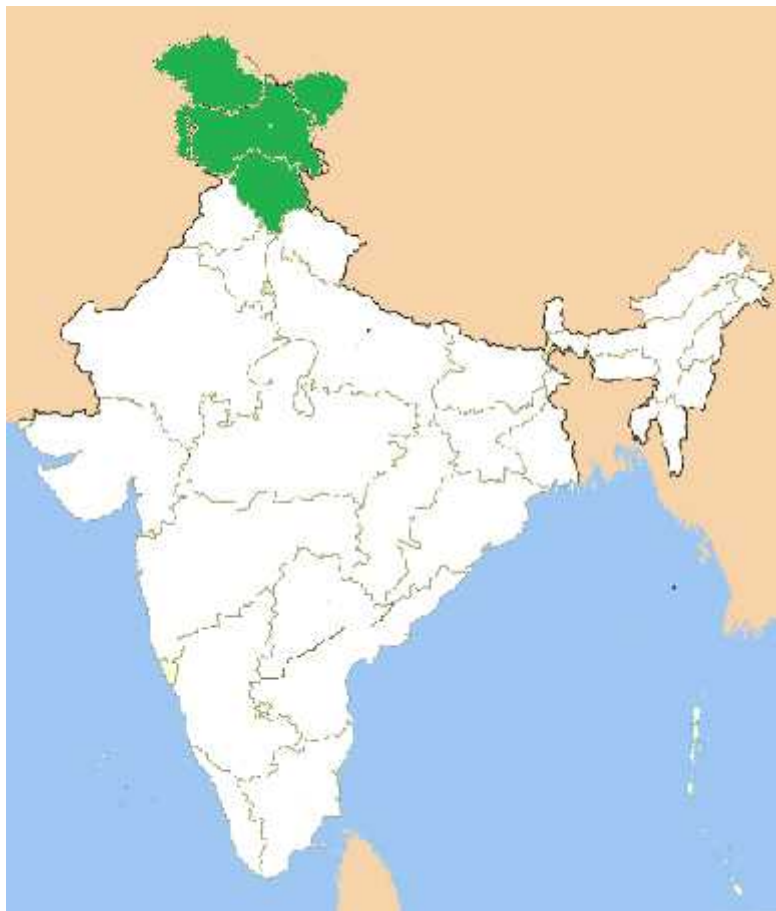

## Jammu & Kashmir

**Reporting AICRP Centre:** Chata

**Area covered:** Kheer Pind, Tanda, and BaggaChanna, Talimorh Villages of Tehsil R. S. Pura (Lat: 32.62104433 Lng: 74.78574592)

**Varieties grown:** Basmati 370, RR564, and PHB 71.

**Crop Stage:** Nursery

**Pest Status:** Nil

**Other observations:** Nil

## Himachal Pradesh

**Reporting AICRP Centre:** Malan

**Area covered:** Mainza and Chimbalhaar Kangra district in H.P.( N 32<sup>0</sup> 10 E 76 48 Altitude 1111m).

**Varieties grown:** Kasturi

**Crop Stage:** Nursery (20-25 days)

**Pest Status:** Low to moderate incidence of hispa, root knot and white tip nematodes. First appearance of rice hispa from these areas during the season, root knot nematodes and white tip nematodes appeared in nursery stage along with nutritional deficiency.

**Other observations:** First appearance of blast symptoms during the season.
