

Varieties grown: Kasturi

Crop Stage: Nursery (20-25 days)

Pest Status: Low to moderate incidence of hispa, root knot and white tip nematodes.

First appearance of rice hispa from these areas during the season, root knot nematodes

and white tip nematodes appeared in nursery stage along with nutritional deficiency.

Other observations: First appearance of blast symptoms during the season.
