- 3. The interview of eligible, short-listed candidates will be held online on the prescribed dates which will be displayed in the ICAR-IIRR website.
- 4. The reporting time for the online interview will be communicated and the candidate should adhere to the instructions.

The candidates will have to send a copy of the filled-in application form duly signed as per the format annexed, along with the self-attested scanned copies of the original documents of the qualifications and a recent photograph pasted onto the scan application.
